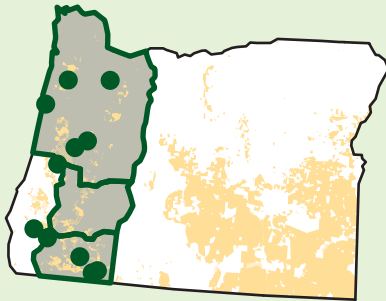

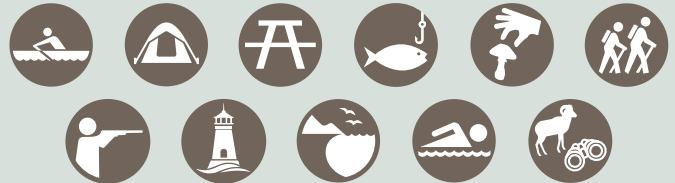
Recreational Assets

Northwest, Medford, and Roseburg Districts

Recreational Values: Boating, camping, day use, fishing, foraging, hiking, hunting, lighthouse, ocean/beach, swimming, wildlife viewing



Description: The project will address outstanding deferred maintenance for various western Oregon recreation sites, administrative facilities, and paved road infrastructure. The project will make structural and mechanical repairs to administrative buildings, repair recreation site water systems, replace wood structures and building roofs, and replace culverts and repair asphalt-surfaced roads.
